Games Committee: A Games Committee will be established during the Sectional

Seeding Meeting according to the IHSA Terms and Conditions.

Timing/Results: Timing and results will be provided by ShaZam Racing through a

F.A.T. System. Weather conditions on the day of the Sectional will determine the direction of the 100 Hurdles/100 Dash. Regardless of direction, the F.A.T system will be used. Results will be posted on Athletic.net Live for review. Once official results are certified by the Meet Referee, they will be posted at the IHSA Schools

Center and on www.athletic.net

Changing Facilities: Teams should arrive to the facility dressed for competition.

Restroom facilities are available underneath the press box.

Meet Staging: Athletes will be staged at the Northwest corner of the track

outside the black fence. Please look for a large green and white

tent.

Warm-up/Track Use: Once running finals begin, no warm-ups, running, hand-offs, etc.

is permitted on the track. No team camps will be allowed on the

inside of the track. Only competitors should be inside the fence/track area. Coaches will be given a coaching badge to wear. Anyone else should be outside the fence. Only ¼ inch pyramid spikes are allowed on any track surface. Marks made on the track surface will be in chalk and chalk will be provided. No tape will be placed on the track or turf and will be immediately

removed.

Turf Protocol: No Food, Gum, or Sunflower Seeds on the turf infield.

Running/Warming up is allowed on the turf infield. However, repetitive striking or stationary drills are not allowed on the turf.

Field Event Access: At all field event venues, a yellow rope barrier will separate the

areas for competitors and coaches/spectators.

Trainer: A certified athletic trainer will be available beginning at 3:00 PM.

He/She will be stationed by the Common Start/Finish Line.

Parking: Buses will enter the West Lot to drop off teams and then proceed

to the North Lot to park during the meet. Spectator parking will be available in the West Lot, East Lot (after 3:30 PM – grass surface

dependent upon dry weather), Grove Lot, and North Lot. Handicapped parking is marked near the main entrance to the

stadium.

Admission: Digital Ticket through GoFan \$7.00. Cash Ticket \$8.00. No

passes will be allowed per IHSA state series guidelines. Gates will open to spectators one hour before field events at 3:00 PM.

Hospitality Room: The hospitality room will be located in the building located at the

north end of the track past the score board. This room is limited

to coaches, officials, administrators, and workers.

Awards: The IHSA Sectional plague will be awarded to the winning team at

the conclusion of the meet at the common start/finish line. Medals for each event will be awarded for 1st – 6th place

according to the Terms and Conditions.

Advancement:

1st and 2nd place will advance to the State Finals in each event. In

addition, individuals and relays who equal or surpass the

qualifying standard, will advance to the State Finals. For field events, any additional competitor who equals or surpasses the qualifying standard in prelims or finals, will advance to the State

Finals.

Weather:

Ordinary poor weather conditions will not stop the races. In the case of extreme/severe weather conditions. Meet Management along with the IHSA officials and Games Committee, may adjust

the time schedule.

Directions to Metamora Twp. H.S. – Sectional Meet:


Traveling West on Route 116, turn right onto Lafayette St. Continue straight for four blocks. Enter the West Student Parking Lot by slightly turning right.
